

Final comments related to the acceptance of the manuscript

Dear Editorial Team,

We would like to express our sincere gratitude to the editors and reviewers for their thorough evaluation and acceptance of our manuscript entitled “Assessing Inter-Model Agreement in Convection-Permitting Simulations of Extreme Winds for Wind Energy Applications”. We are pleased to submit the final version and outline below, with the minimal corrections made during our final proofreading:

1. Section 3.3 (line 284): We removed a redundant word (“*termed*”) that malformed the sentence. The text now reads: “...*which enables one to use the entire set of independent events (temporally uncorrelated local maxima termed ‘ordinary events’, see Section 3.3.1), instead of annual maxima...*”

2. Section 5.2 (line 457): We corrected an erroneous figure panel cross-reference. “*Fig. 4d*” has been changed to “*Fig. 4c*”, which is the panel displaying the PC3 loadings described in that paragraph. Figure 4 contains only three panels (a, b, c).

3. Section 3.2.2 (line 276): We resolved a remaining inconsistency within the section product of a previous review iteration. The phrase “*monthly maximum wind speeds*” has been corrected to “*monthly 99th percentile wind speeds*”, consistent with the analysis described in the introductory paragraph of the same section, the correction requested in the initial review iteration, and with the title of Figure 5.

4. Section 5.4 (line 528): Added a missing ending point at the end of a paragraph.

5. Reference list: The reference to Correa-Sánchez et al. (2025b) has been updated from the Wind Energy Science Discussions (discussion paper) version to the final published article.

No changes were made to the scientific content, results, or conclusions of the manuscript.
